If you were accused of being a Christian, would there be enough evidence to convict you?

The Bible only uses the word "Christian" three times, but Christian is just another name for a disciple of Christ (Acts 11:26). So then, how can we prove to be His disciples?

In Luke 6:40, Jesus said,

"A disciple is not above his teacher; but everyone who is perfectly trained will be like his teacher."

Are you like Jesus?

In John 8:31, Jesus said,

"If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed."

Do you abide in the word of Jesus?

In John 13:35, Jesus said,

"By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

Do you love your fellow disciples in Christ?

In John 15:8, Jesus said,

"By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples."

Do you bear much fruit for the glory of the Father?

Right now, you are building a case to prove that you are a disciple of Christ. The Judgment is coming. What will be the verdict?
